**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$295, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$13,065 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

**Face Value:** 1.00 USD

**Total Produced:** 40,000 \*\*

**Silver Content:** 90%

**Extra Info:** The O mint mark stands for New Orleans, and means this dollar is worth about 4x as much as one with no mint mark. These dollars are .90 silver and at the time their melt value was worth more than face value much like the nickels and pennies of today.
