**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$10, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$650 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

**Extra Info:** Numbers and values above reflect the non copper version of the 1864 Indian Head Penny. There are 2 main flavors to the 1864 Indian Head Penny. Those with an L and those without. The L can be found on the obverse (front) of the coin on a ribbon. With an L is worth about 4x as much as the same coin without the L. Proofs of this coin are available in L and no L as

well, but the numbers are all over the place and it's hard to pin down a true value.
