Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$120, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$49,000 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: The 1879 CC (Carson City) Morgan Silver Dollars are a must have for any serious Morgan aficionado, but with a top end value up in the tens of thousands its not an investment to be taken lightly. High end versions of this coin are hard to price really. Back in 2014 one sold for \$49,937 at auction, but they seem to sell for around \$20,000 more often. Really depends upon

the specimen.
