Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$100, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$5,600 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: Just under a million barber half dollars were minted at the San Francisco mint in 1897. These coins are valued much higher than the ones from Philadelphia (the no mint mark ones) One in MS-63 condition will be worth around 4 thousand dollars. Photo a bit blurry sorry.
