**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$3, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$650 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

**Silver Content:** 90%

**Extra Info:** The Barber dime was actually named the liberty head dime. The dime gets its nick name from Charles Barber the cheif engraver of the mint at the time of design. These are 90% silver!
