Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$12, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$1,400 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: The 1913 Barber Quarters are the most widely produced coins issued in 1913 but they are still worth a bunch of money if you can find one in good condition. If you were to find a 1913 Barber Quarter in a drawer or piggy bank somewhere there is a 75% chance that it was issued at the Denver mint according to the US Mint logs.
