**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$15, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$17,000 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

**Silver Content:** 90%

**Extra Info:** The most valuable Walking Liberty Half Dollars were minted in the D or Denver mint in 1920. In ms-63 condition these can fetch near \$4,000 and thats more than pocket change.
