Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$210, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$3,800 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: The 1921 Standing Liberty Quarter was minted at the (p) Philadelphia and only the Philadelphia mint. These quarters are super duper rare if you notice just 1.9 million quarters were issued in 1921...at all. This is a nice addition to any coin collectors collection.
