Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$12, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$3,100 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: The mint mark on the 1929 Walking Liberty Half Dollar is on the reverse. Liberties are 90% silver. There were no Half Dollars minted at the Philadelphia mint this year.
