Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$5, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$45 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: 70% of all quarters minted in 1943 were 1943 P Washington Quarters. There were no proofs issued. Not sure what was up with the US Mints in 1942, and 1943, but all have double die errors. These are on the front again this year and worth around \$320 to \$1,850 dependent upon coin and market conditions.
