**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$3, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$35 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

**Extra Info:** The (d) 1945 Mercury Dime was minted in Denver. If you are wondering where the mint mark is on mercury dimes its on the back right next to the word "one". These dimes are 90% silver and a must have for any collector. When buying or selling Mercury Dimes full bands are key.
