Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$1030, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$103,000 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: There are several variations of the 1796 Draped Bust Dollars, and as usual they can get a bit confusing. There is one version with 10 stars on the left and 6 stars on the right, 1 version with 9 stars on the left and 7 on the right with small letters, and then 1 version with 9 stars on the left and 7 stars on the right but with small lettering. The version with 9 stars on the left and 7 stars

on the right but with small lettering must be harder to find because it tends to sell for 30% more than the other 2 versions.
