Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$45, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$7,361 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Silver Content: 90%

Extra Info: Numbers above for the non 25 over 50 version. If the reverse of this coin has a 25 over 50 then its worth 10x as much. Just a heads up. There seems to have been a tendency of the mint to reuse old coins as many of the 1822 to 1828 Drapped Bust Quarters are some version of a re-strike.
