Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$30, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$415 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: 1876 is another great year for those collecting Indian Head Cents. The mintage / production numbers dropped from 13.5 million in the previous year to just under 8 million in 1876.
