Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$57, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$29,500 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: These are the rarest of all the 1904 Barber Half Dollars minted with just over half a million ever created. One of these coins even in piss poor shape is worth more than most collectible coins. These coins have sold for around \$20,000 in great (MS-63) condition at auctions and online. Of course a coin of this value has few buyers so if you own one you wont want to sell it in haste, and if you are planning on buying one you may want a

second opinion or some sort of certification on coin quality.
