Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$29, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$1,000 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Silver Content: 90%

Extra Info: Just 510 thousand Barber dimes were issued at the (s) San Francisco mint in 1913. These dimes are pretty rare and one in good condition could easily go for a few hundred dollars. These are 90% silver, meaning they contain around .0723 oz of pure silver.
