**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in poor condition will be valued at somewhere around \$800, while one in great shape can bring \$20000. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say poor, we mean worn more than would be expected from a coin in this age, and perfect meaning it looks perfect without flaw and possibly even certified.\*

**Total Produced:** 247,000 \*\*

**Gold Content:** 90%

**Extra Info:** There were D, S, and non mint marked 1914 Indian Head Gold Eagles. As a general rule of thumb these coins with the S mint mark are worth slightly more than those with the D (Denver) or no mint mark.
