Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$10, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$1,901 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: 21% of the 1916 Barber Quarters were minted at the Philadelphia mint, making them the most prevalent of the 1916 Barber Quarters. This is the LAST YEAR that these coins were issued. They were replaced by the Standing Liberty quarters later this same year. This means you can find both Barber and Standing Liberty Quarters with 1916 dates. No quarters were issued at the

San Fran mint for this year.
