**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$18, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$10,500 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.
