Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$3, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$900 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: With 26.6 million mercury/winged liberty dimes minted the Philadelphia minted coins represent the largest portion of the dimes minted in 1918. These coins are of course 90% silver. Mercury dimes are at a premium when they have FB or Full Bands.
