**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$29, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$180,500 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

**Face Value:** 0.50 USD

**Total Produced:** 1,165,000 \*\*

**Silver Content:** 90%

**Extra Info:** MS-65 versions of this 1919 D Half Dollar have historically sold for between \$80,000 and \$200,000 at top auction companies like HA (heritage auctions). This makes the 1919 D Walking Liberty Half Dollar the most valuable in the series. Most of the coins from this year and mint were circulated and well worn. Its easy to find one in poor condition for under \$100 but near

impossible to find one in a high MS grade. This is a key date to look out for.
