Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in poor condition will be valued at somewhere around \$13000, while one in great shape can bring \$150000. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say poor, we mean worn more than would be expected from a coin in this age, and perfect meaning it looks perfect without flaw and possibly even certified.*

Extra Info: The Indian Head Gold Eagles were produced sporadically throughout the early 1900s. It has been 6 years since the mint issued this coin, and would be another 4 before it would make another.
