Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around 75 cents, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$900 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: The 1920 Wheat Penny may have the following errors; Lamination errors - the outer layer of the coin may be flaked off or have cracks. Off-center strikes - die strike is off center. Argentina Planchets (just 15 known) - its a 1920 wheat cent struck on a foreign Argentina 10 centavos planchet. Will look super worn. Check google for images. Coin is a copper nickel alloy.
