Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$500, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$3,500 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: 1928 was the last year the Peace Dollar was issued this decade. It was not until 1934 that the US Mint would continue with the minting of this particular Dollar. This mintage (Philadelphia) is worth substantially more than the 1928 Peace dollars minted elsewhere. If this coin is in great condition and sold to a collector it might bring up to \$5,000 and thats no chump change. Just 360 thousand Peace dollars were issued at this mint.
