**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$8, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$4,820 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

**Extra Info:** There are 3 things to look out for when determining the value of a 1932 Washington Quarter. 1.) Double Dies on the words "in god we trust" are worth between 85 and \$4,800.00 , 2.) Light motto, and heavy mottoes. The heavy and light motto is on the words "in god we trust" as well.
