**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$27, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$650 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

**Face Value:** 1.00 USD

**Total Produced:** 1,576,000 \*\*

**Silver Content:** 90%

**Extra Info:** 1935 was the final year for the peace dollar, and the 90% standard Silver Dollar. These are really nice coins, I actually have a 1935 peace dollar that I carry around as a good luck piece. This coin should not have a mint mark since its from the Philadelphia mint, but if it did the mint mark would be on the reverse side just under the word "one".
