**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$7, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$65 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

**Face Value:** 0.25 USD

**Total Produced:** 33,540,000 \*\*

**Silver Content:** 90%

**Extra Info:** The total US Mint output of Washington Silver Quarter Dollars for the year 1939 was nearly 20,000,000 more than issued the year before. This fact makes the 1939 Quarters worth significantly less than the 1938 minted coins. Almost 9 thousand proofs were issued this year at the Philadelphia mint as well. Proofs are selling for just over \$400 on a good day.
