**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$2, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$50 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

**Face Value:** 0.10 USD

**Total Produced:** 60,740,000 \*\*

**Silver Content:** 90%

**Extra Info:** The Mercury or Winged Liberty dimes from 1942 are 90% silver! In addition there is a semi-common error where the mint stamped a 2 over the 1 in the date. This also happened at the Philadelphia mint as well. The ones from the Denver mint are worth between \$600 and \$8,000 to a collector.
