Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around 15 cents, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$8 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: Look for the S over the D mint mark error on the 1944 Wheat Penny. One in good condition can fetch \$100-500. One of the most valuable pennies ever minted was the **rare** [1944 S Steel Wheat](#) and they have sold for over 100,000 in the past. Wow..that is one hunk of change.
