Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$7, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$69 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Silver Content: 40%

Extra Info: The numbers and values above are for the S (San Francisco) minted 1971 Ike Dollars. If you look at the mintage numbers you can see only 6.8 million of these were issued. Compare that number to the 68 million issued in Denver that year and you can see how rare the S minted Eisenhower dollars are. This is because congress only agreed to issue limited 40% silver

dollars and these were to be included in collector sets sold by the mint.
