Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$5.00, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$40 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: A rough total of 5 million 1973 Eisenhower Dollars were minted at the San Francisco. The content and value of these coins vary. There are silver and non silver proofs, as well as non proof silvers issued. The silver ones are worth between \$10 and \$40 usually, while the non silver proofs are worth much less. Not all of these contain the 40% silver.
