**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around 50 cents, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$25 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

**Face Value:** 0.50 USD

**Total Produced:** 3,677,000 \*\*

**Silver Content:** 0%

**Extra Info:** There are 2 variations in the 1979 S Kennedy Half Dollars and neither is an error as far as we know. However the Flat S version is the rarest and worth more to collectors. The Flat S coins are worth around \$20 to \$25 while the Clear S coins are worth around \$8 each. All of the 3.6 million Half Dollars issued here at the San Francisco mint were minted as proofs.
