**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around 25 cents, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$2 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

**Extra Info:** The Mississippi state quarter was engraved by Donna Weaver who also did the other state quarters before and after this release. It was issued October 15th 2002 to the public. The reverse or back of the coin has the words The Magnolia State, as well as 2 flowers (Magnolia Blossoms the State Flower). I would have expected it to have the Mighty Mississippi or something like

that but they just went with flowers. :)
