Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$35, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$12,000 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: This was the first year that the Morgan Silver Dollar was minted. There are several variations and these in these variations various values. There are 8 Feathered Morgans (prices above for the 8TF version), 7 Feather Morgans, and more. In short there are many different dies for the 1878 and if you dont know what you are buying you may want to get this coin looked at by a 3rd party professional. We wont do this much, but the 1878

Morgan silver dollars are worth \$\$\$ and are very hard to judge so, and because of this there is a huge range of values for this coin.
