Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$33.00, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$145 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: There were 762 of the 1896 Morgan Silver Dollars issued as proofs. Sometimes the regular non proof coins are worth more than the proofs, but this year they are not. Since nearly 10 million Morgans were issued the proofs are rare in comparison. These proofs are selling for somewhere between \$2,450 and \$2,800.
