Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$10, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$2,000 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: There were only 380 1914 Barber Quarter proofs issued this year at the Philadelphia mint this year, making these the rarest of the Barber Proofs for any year. Because of their rarity the proofs are worth around \$950 or \$100 more than and other proof but the 1915 Barber Proof. Tje Philadelphia mint issued around 60% of all the barbers for the year.
