Mint Mark: No mint mark

Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$2808, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$18,000 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Silver Content: 90%

Extra Info: The 1916 Standing Liberty Quarter Dollars are very very very rare. Just over 50,000 of them were ever minted, and it is certain that many of those have been melted down. The Bald Eagle is on the reverse and there are NO stars under the eagle this year. When the coin was redesigned the eagle was moved up slightly and 3 stars were placed below it. Look out for fakes or



replicas!
