Mint Mark: No mint mark

Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$3.00, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$800 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Silver Content: 90%

Extra Info: As always the (p) minted Mercury dimes in 1919 were the most widely minted coins this year. With somewhere around 60% of the total production. These dimes are 90% silver. Mercury dimes are at a premium when they have FB or Full Bands.
