**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$2.00, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$400 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

**Silver Content:** 90%

**Extra Info:** In 1920 (p) Philadelphia minted 90% of all the mercury dimes. The mercury silver dimes have their mint marks on the reverse or back of the coin. These coins are 90% silver, and a big favorite of the collector. The 1920 P dime is a great entry level dime for the year. Mercury dimes are at a premium when they have FB or Full Bands.
