Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$25, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$1,400 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

Silver Content: 90%

Extra Info: Over 9 million of the 1923 P Quarters were issued at the Philadelphia mint this year. This is about 90% of all the quarters for the year. There were no quarters minted at the Denver mint for the year, just the P and the S mints.
