Mint Mark: No mint mark

Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$3.00, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$400 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Silver Content: 90%

Extra Info: The mercury dime is a staple of the United States coin collecting community. The coins are 90% silver. This coin does not have a mint mark, but is from Philadelphia. The mint marks are located on the reverse of the coin next to the word "one". Roughly 64% percent of the mercury dimes minted in 1924 were from the (p) Philadelphia mint. The (d) and (s) made up the other 35%. When buying or selling Mercury Dimes full bands are key.
