Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$3.00, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$300 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Extra Info: 80% of the entire stock of the 90% silver 1926 Mercury Dimes were issued here at the (p) Philadelphia mint. They are not that rare when compared with the (S) and (D). They are therefore not worth as much to a collector. When buying or selling Mercury Dimes full bands are key.
