Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in poor condition will be valued at somewhere around \$70000, while one in great shape can bring \$600000. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say poor, we mean worn more than would be expected from a coin in this age, and perfect meaning it looks perfect without flaw and possibly even certified.*

Extra Info: 1933 was the last year that the Indian Head Gold Eagles were minted. Most of these coins were melted down when Roosevelt banned gold ownership.
