Mint Mark: No mint mark

Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$9.00, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$250 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Silver Content: 90%

Extra Info: The (p) Philadelphia mint issued no proofs for this year. In the past the Walking Liberty proofs were issued here, but they failed to do so in 1935 for some reason. This coin with no min mark is work much less than the same coin with a D or and S. MS-65 still brings a few hundred dollars.
