Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around \$3.00, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$40 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.

Silver Content: 90%

Extra Info: 1956 was the first time in 15 years that the Roosevelt dimes were only minted at 2 locations. (the P and the D) The last time was 1949. 108 million dimes were minted at both facilities. These coins are 90% Silver so stock up :) Look for full bands when buying and selling these Roosevelt Dimes.
