**Value:** As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around 1 cent, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$22 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified\*.

**Extra Info:** 1.6 million pennies were minted as proofs as part of the above number. The proof 1960 Lincoln Cents or pennies are valued at around \$1.90 There were small and large date 1960 pennies issued and unlike the ones minted in [Philadelphia](#) these coins are worth the same no matter what the date size.
