Value: As a rough estimate of this coins value you can assume this coin in average condition will be valued at somewhere around 10 cents, while one in mint state (MS) condition could bring \$3 at auction if certified. This price does not reference any standard coin grading scale. So when we say average, we mean worn as would be expected from a coin in this age, and mint state meaning MS+ grade and certified*.
